## **Acceptable Items**

**PAPER:** Office paper, construction paper, newspaper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, corrugated cardboard, telephone books, and cardboard food boxes.

**GLASS:** Clear brown and green glass that previously contained food or beverages. *No broken glass, please!*

**STEEL:** Any food container (e.g. soup cans, canned vegetables, etc.) *It is okay to leave the labels on.*

**ALUMINUM:** Beverage containers (e.g. soda)

**PLASTIC:** Only containers with numbers 1-7 can be recycled at the centers. Look on the bottom of the container for the chasing arrows symbol. The number inside the arrows represents the type of plastic.

## **Recycling Reminders**

- Staples, paper clips and rubber bands should be removed from all paper.
- Cardboard should be broken down to conserve space in the bins.
- All food containers should be rinsed and lids removed.
- All recyclable should be loose in the recycling bins -- no bagged materials.
